

The social aspects of the play:

Avery is an African-American university student, middle class, but something is not quite right with his world. A film fanatic, he's taking a sabbatical from college, he's in therapy, we don't know why; sexuality issues, eating disorder, family problems?

Sam has no education and is struggling to make ends meet, this is the only kind of job he can get and he relies on it for his main income. There is no social system to fall back on in America.
